Poet, author, and musician Chester Anderson (1932–91) was a member of the Beat Generation and an editor of underground journals in New York and San Francisco. His novel *The Butterfly Kid* was nominated for a Hugo Award in 1968 and is a prime example of science fiction's New Wave Movement, a stylistically experimental trend of the 60s and 70s.

Michael Kurland is the author of several science-fiction books as well as a detective series based on characters from the Sherlock Holmes mysteries. His nonfiction works include *The Spymaster's Handbook* and *How to Solve a Murder: The Forensic Handbook*.

T. A. Waters (1938–98) was a magician and writer of magic books as well as a science-fiction author. His brochures and pamphlets on mentalism and bizarre magic are collected in the anthology *Mind, Myth & Magick*.
