Maximus of Tyre, active probably in the latter half of the second century AD, was a devoted Platonist whose only surviving work consists of forty-one brief addresses on various topics of ethical, philosophical, and theological import including the nature of divinity, the immortality of the soul, the sources of good and evil, the injustice of vengeance, the tyranny of pleasures and desires, the contribution of the liberal arts, and the pursuit of happiness, among many others. Drawing on the Hellenic cultural tradition from Homer to the death of Alexander the Great, Maximus offers a rich collection of the famous philosophical, literary, and historical figures, events, ideas, successes, and failures that constituted Greek *paideia* in the so-called Second Sophistic era.

This edition offers a fresh translation, ample annotation, and a text fully informed by current scholarship.

### PLACITA

**AETIUS**

*Placita* (*Tenets*), generally attributed to an author named Aëtius and dating from the late first or early second century AD, was a compendium setting out in summary fashion the principal doctrines and opinions of philosophers and philosophical schools in response to questions and topics in the domain of natural philosophy. Now lost, *Placita* can be largely reconstructed from the work of three authors working in the period from the second to the fifth century (Pseudo-Plutarch, Stobaeus, and Theodoret) who quote from it extensively. Designed as a multi-purpose resource, *Placita* long served as a manual of neatly packaged doxographic material on a wide variety of topics, and it remains a valuable source for our knowledge of Presocratic and Hellenistic philosophy. This edition offers a fresh translation, ample annotation, and a text fully informed by the latest scholarship.

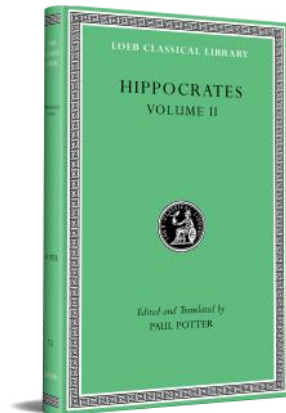

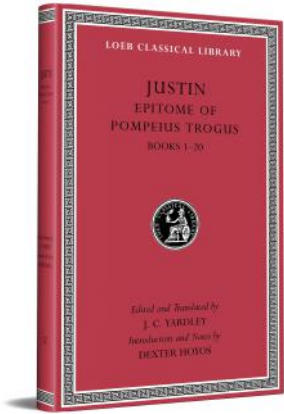

To Justin (Marcus Junian(i)us Justinus), otherwise unknown, is attributed our abbreviated version of the lost *Philippic History* by (Gnaeus?) Pompeius Trogus, a massive account of the non-Roman world and its civilizations, from mythic beginnings through Alexander the Great, the Hellenistic kingdoms, and Parthia. Trogus' work thus complemented the monumental history of Rome by his Augustan contemporary, Livy, and in high style traced similar moral themes: rulers and states that lack such virtues as moderation, justice, and piety bring harm or ruin on themselves, and often on their realms as well. Justin's anthology became one of the most widely read and influential books in the Middle Ages and Renaissance, indeed the main authority on world history other than Roman, surviving in more than 200 manuscripts.

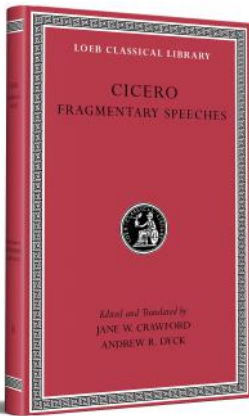
Cicero (Marcus Tullius, 106–43 BC), Roman advocate, orator, politician, poet, and philosopher, lived through the stirring era that saw the rise, dictatorship, and death of Julius Caesar in a tottering republic. In Cicero's political speeches and in his correspondence, we see the excitement, tension and intrigue of politics and the important part he played in the turmoil of the time.

Although Cicero's oratory is well attested, the sixteen speeches that survive only in quotations nevertheless fill gaps in our knowledge. These speeches attracted the interest of later authors, particularly Asconius and Quintilian, for their exemplary content, oratorical strategies, or use of language. The fragmentary speeches fall, like Cicero's career in general, into three periods: the preconular, the consular, and the postconsular, and here are presented chronologically, numbered continuously, and their fragments arranged, insofar as

possible, in the order in which they would have occurred, followed by unplaced quotations. Each speech receives an introduction and ample notation. This edition includes all speeches with attested fragments, together with testimonia; based upon Crawford's edition of 1994, the sources have been examined afresh, and newer source-editions substituted where appropriate.

LIVES OF THE SOPHISTS. LIVES OF PHILOSOPHERS AND SOPHISTS

PHILOSTRATUS  
EUNAPIUS

Flavius Philostratus was born to a distinguished family with close ties to Lesbos in the later second century, and died around the middle of the third. A sophist who studied at Athens and later lived in Rome, Philostratus provides in *Lives of the Sophists* a treasury of information about notable practitioners. His sketches of sophists in action paint a fascinating picture of their predominant influence in the educational, social, and political life of the Empire in his time. He is almost certainly the author also of the *Life of Apollonius of Tyana* (LCL 16, 17, 458) and *Heroicus* and *Gymnasticus* (LCL 521).

Eunapius (ca. 345–415) was born in Sardis but studied and spent much of his life in Athens as a sophist and historian. His *Lives of Philosophers and Sophists* covers figures of personal or intellectual significance to him in the period from Plotinus (ca. 250) to Chrysanthus (ca. 380), including one remarkable woman, Sosipatra, and then focuses on Iamblichus and his students. The work's underlying rationale combines personal devotion to teachers and colleagues with a broader attempt to rehabilitate Hellenic cultural icons against the rise of Christianity and the influence of its representatives.

This edition of Philostratus and Eunapius thoroughly revises the original edition by Wilmer C. Wright (1921) in light of modern scholarship.

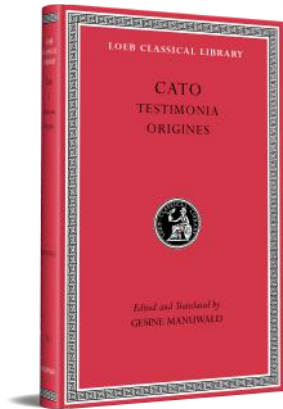

M. Porcius Cato (234–149 BC), one of the best-known figures of the middle Roman Republic, remains legendary for his political and military career, especially his staunch opposition to Carthage; his modest way of life; his integrity of character and austere morality; his literary works, composed in a style at once sophisticated and down-to-earth; his pithy sayings; and his drive to define and to champion Roman national character and traditions in the face of challenges from Greek culture.

These two volumes join the Loeb edition of Cato's only extant work, *On Agriculture* (LCL 283), by supplying all testimonia about, and all fragments by or attributed to Cato. Highlights are *Origines*, the first historical work attested in Latin, a history of Rome from its founding to the onset of the first Punic War, as well as the origins of major Italian cities; his orations, regarded as the beginning of Roman oratory; *To His Son Marcus*, which inaugurated a Roman tradition of didactic pieces addressed by fathers to their sons; *Military Matters*; the *Poem on Morals*; letters; commentaries on civil law; and memorable sayings.

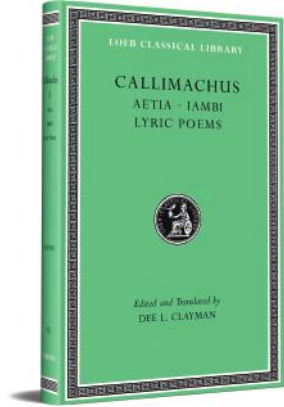

**CALLIMACHUS**

**Edited and translated by Dee L. Clayman**

Callimachus (ca. 303–ca. 235 BC) came as a young man to the court of the Ptolemies at Alexandria, where he composed poetry for the royal family; helped establish the Library and Museum as a world center of literature, science, and scholarship; and wrote an estimated 800 volumes of poetry and prose on an astounding variety of subjects.

Callimachus' vast learning richly informs his poetry, which ranges broadly and reworks the language and generic properties of his predecessors in inventive, refined, and expressive ways. This edition, which replaces the earlier Loeb editions by A. W. Mair (1921) and C. A. Trypanis (1954, 1958), presents all that currently survives of and about Callimachus and his works, including the ancient commentaries (*Diegeseis*) and scholia. Volume I contains *Aetia*, *Iambi*, and lyric poems; Volume II, *Hecale*, *Hymns*, and *Epigrams*; and Volume III, miscellaneous epics and elegies, other fragments, and testimonia, together with concordances and a general index.

The *Fragmentary Republican Latin* series continues with three highly influential pioneers in the creation and development of Latin poetry.

Livius Andronicus (born ca. 292 BC) was regarded by the Romans as the founder of Latin literature. Naevius (born ca. 280–260), though most famous for his comedies, also wrote tragedy and epic, innovating by incorporating Roman material into his Greek models. Caecilius (born probably in the 220s), a friend of the older Ennius, excelled at comedy, of which he was Rome's leading exponent during his career, and was so considered by posterity. The texts are based on the most recent and reliable editions of the source authors and have been revised, freshly translated, and amply annotated in light of current scholarship.
